

2022 PSO Natural Gas Storage RFP

Technical Conference – Question & Answer

Q. How much storage are you seeking?

A. As stated within Appendix A on page 5, we're seeking offers up to a maximum storage quantity of 1 Bcf.

Q. Are you looking for storage on a particular pipeline or connected to a particular asset?

A. Yes, as stated in Section 2.1 on page 4, the proposed natural gas storage facility must have a standard receipt point on the Enable Oklahoma Intrastate Transmission pipeline system.

Q. Is there any consideration of a weighted scale to items 1, 2 and 3 in Section 3.2 Evaluation and Award?

A. There is not a specific weighted average formula that we're using to balance offers. Total cost is paramount, but there may be a situation where we'd pay a higher price for additional flexibility. When the offers are received, and if there are competing offers (lower cost versus additional flexibility) we will need to assess and justify our final decision.

Q. Is there a predetermined evaluation tool?

A. We do not have a predetermined evaluation tool.

Q. In Section 3.2 Evaluation and Award, are the most important evaluation items in order of priority?

A. Yes, total cost is very important to us. However, if we receive offers that include significant flexibility, such flexibility will certainly be considered (even though total cost may be higher).
